When ordering replacement steering and suspension components for GMC, Chevrolet and Cadillac trucks and SUVs, an assembly plant code may be denoted in the OEM factory service manual and or other sources of part number look-up information. This code represents the plant and geographic location of where the vehicle was originally assembled.

The assembly plant codes and location for North American GM trucks and SUVs are below:

Plant Code	Location
CMD	Flint, Michigan
FWI	Fort Wayne, Indiana
MSL	Silao, Mexico

Unless otherwise explicitly noted, Mevotech steering and suspension components are direct fit replacements, regardless of the original assembly plant. Refer to www.mevotech.com for the most current application information and part number look-up.
