Prior to commencing any steering or suspension repair on Mercedes-Benz vehicles equipped with E-Active Body Control, it is imperative that the Professional Technician have a thorough and complete understanding of all related safety, technical and operational considerations.

This system combines the conventional Airmatic air suspension system with new semi-supporting hydro-pneumatics. Furthermore, this system utilizes a 48V operating voltage as part of the hybrid system to avoid overstraining the vehicle's regular 12V.

Improper repair procedures may result in premature part failure, incorrect operation of one or more vehicle sub-systems and or personal injury.

Always ensure to refer to the factory service manual for correct diagnosis, removal and installation procedures, cautions, fastening torque values and sequences and alignment values and sequences, where applicable.
