



## Labor Saver™: 2009-2003 Nissan 350Z and 2007-2003 Infiniti G35 Front Lower Rearward Control Arm Tapered Sleeve

During a front lower rearward control arm replacement service on certain Nissan and Infiniti RWD coupes, in some cases the steering knuckle tapered sleeve will become seized to either the ball joint portion of the old control arm.

If the sleeve must be removed either for re-use, it must be separated carefully. A combination of penetrating oil and a three-jaw puller will usually suffice. All rust and corrosion must be cleaned from the sleeve. Additionally, the sleeve and mating component must be inspected for any damage and or an 'out-of-round' condition. Do not re-use the sleeve or mating component if signs of damage or abnormal wear are found during inspection.

However, if the sleeve cannot be reused or is damaged a new one must be sourced.

The below noted Mevotech Supreme front lower rearward control arms include a new anti-corrosion coated sleeve for a frustration-free installation. **See Figure 1.**
